#### The Study:

The City of Toronto and the Toronto Transit Commission are conducting preliminary planning for the extension of the Scarborough Rapid Transit line to significantly improve the transit service to the north and east of the Scarborough City Centre. Previous Open Houses were held in April and June 2008 to examine potential alignments for an extension of the Scarborough Rapid Transit (SRT) from McCowan Station to the Malvern Town Centre. Planning currently underway will lead to a Transit Project Assessment under the Environmental Assessment (EA) Act.
